BAD NEWS: We are sorry to announce that there will be no Youth Day Camp during September 2010. Because WERGF is hosting the Wisconsin State Sporting Clays Shoot during August of '10, there has been no time to conduct the necessary fundraising activities, nor will we be able to schedule the various vendors and volunteers that Youth Day requires. Please accept our apologies.

GOOD NEWS: We have sufficient funding and volunteers to again offer our Youth 2-Bird Pheasant Hunt on Sept. 11th, 2010. This will be open to the first 100 applicants. Youth must be ages 12 to 16 and have a hunter's safety certificate. There will be a nominal charge of \$10 per applicant to help defray some of the costs.

Application, required waiver form, and photo permission can be found online at www.whisperingemeraldridge.com, or by phoning 715-233-1281. In order to register, a check for \$10 must accompany the application. A hunting time will be scheduled 9 am to 5 pm based on availability and your needs. A guide and hunting dog will be provided. If the shooter needs a shotgun, we will have a selection available. Shotgun rounds can also be provided should you need them.

We will also provide a staffed shooting station at Lookout Lounge for the hunters to practice with their weapons prior to the hunt. You should plan to arrive ½ hour before your scheduled hunt, or even earlier if you wish to practice shooting.

BETTER NEWS: Plans are already in place to hold the necessary fundraisers and schedule the vendors and volunteers for a full and complete YOUTH DAY on the 1st Saturday after Labor Day in 2011.

We thank you for your understanding in this matter and look forward to serving those of you that enter our Youth Hunt this year, and those who attend Youth Day Camp in 2011.
