- Artwork will be required to have a jazz inspired theme, and must be all-age appropriate.
- All paintings to be hung must be original, framed, and equipped with hanging wire.
- There is a limited amount of space available for 3-D artwork.
- Customer will contact artist directly regarding sales; no commission will be charged to artist for sales.
- Venue will not be responsible for loss, theft or damage of artwork.
- Eau Claire Jazz Festival volunteers are not responsible for loss, costs, or damages to the artists and/or their inventory. All artists will be required to accept responsibility for their own insurance.
- Participants need to sign and return agreement below with payment.

This needs to be done on the date and time specified by the Art Committee unless previous arrangements have been made. ** **Times are negotiable. Special arrangements are possible.
