The Eau Claire YMCA believes in providing membership and program services to all who desire to participate. The YMCA's Scholarship Program, supported in part through contributions to the Strong Kids Campaign and the United Way of Greater Eau Claire, provides membership and program scholarships for those in need within our available resources. Those individuals or families not able to pay the full membership or program fee may be awarded financial assistance as determined by the following guidelines.

This application must be filled out completely with the necessary income documents attached before it can be considered.

Applicants with proper income verification can be approved immediately at the YMCA Service Desk during business hours.

Application and income verification can also be sent to the Eau Claire YMCA. Applicants will be notified by mail or email regarding the status of their application. Please allow two weeks for mailed applications to be reviewed and processed.

Terms & Conditions

Please read through each of the statements below. This section must be signed for your application to be reviewed.

1. You must provide an accurate proof of your total household income. This can be in the form of a social security benefit statement or previous year's tax return (1040). Pay stubs and W-2's will not serve as acceptable income verification.

Scholarships are awarded for the duration of up to one year. Annually you must complete a new financial assistance application and attach your most recent income verification.

1 3. Fees can be paid using a monthly deduction bank plan or paid quarterly at the service desk.

2 If you default in payment two or more times, your scholarship will be terminated and you will become ineligible to reapply until a one year time period has passed.

4. Any person suspended or terminated from the YMCA for inappropriate behavior will no longer be eligible for financial assistance. Suspension or termination will be at the discretion of the YMCA staff.

One scholarship is awarded per family per year. If you do not complete the term of the membership you will be ineligible to reapply until the one year anniversary date has passed.
