



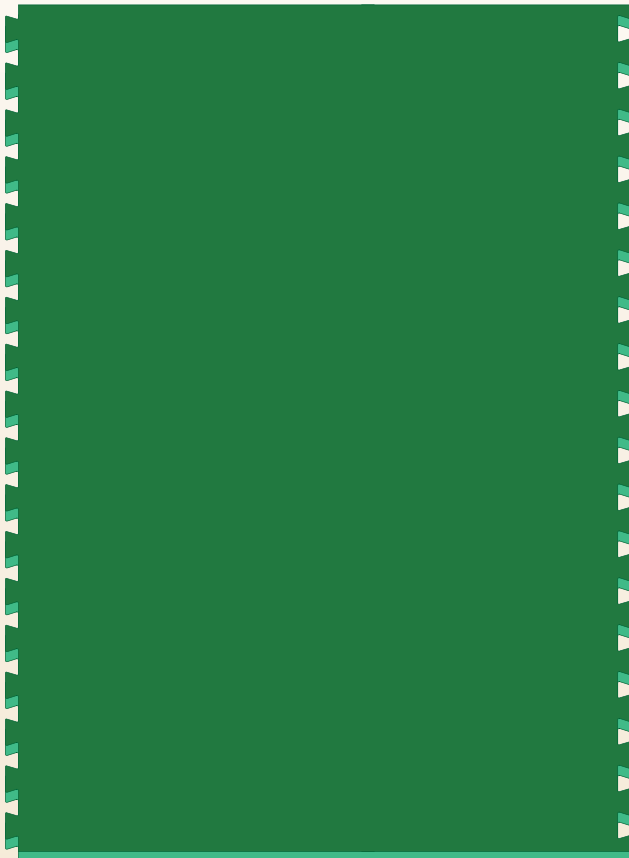

Basic Installation Recommendations

For a detailed installation instructions refer to the installation manual.

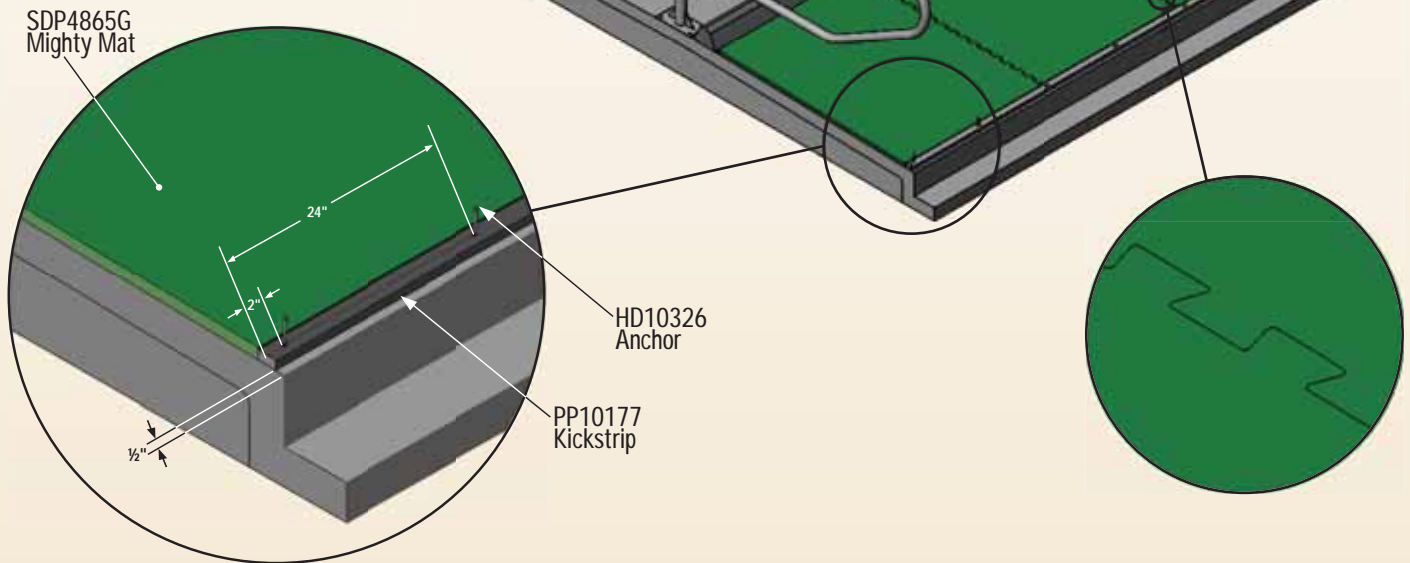
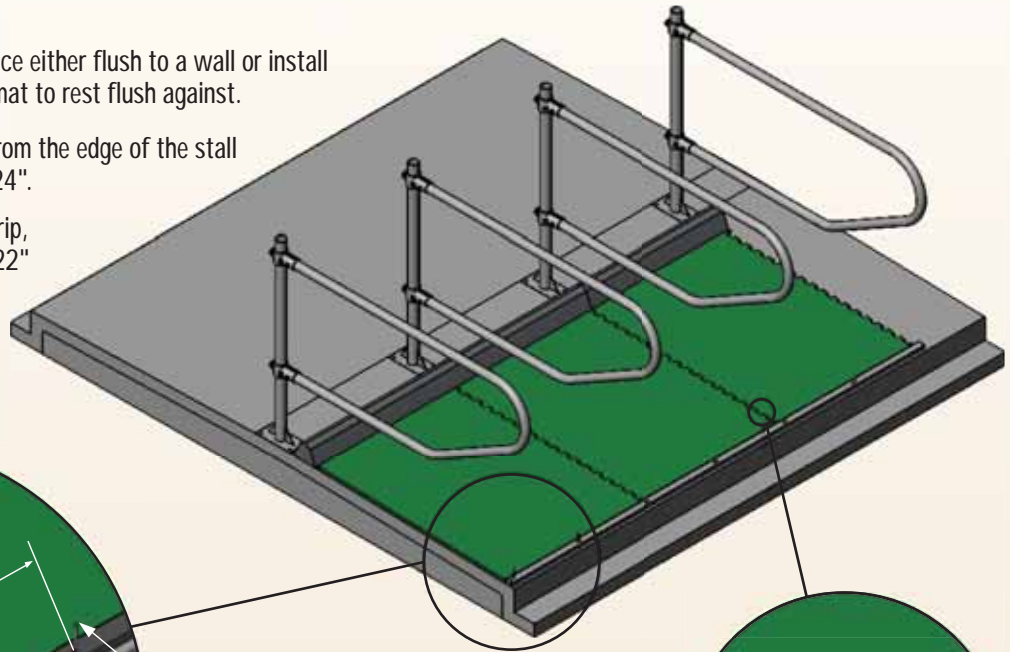
Kickstrip

Trim beginning and ending mats and place either flush to a wall or install another piece of kickstrip for trimmed mat to rest flush against.

For alley edge install the kickstrip 1/2" from the edge of the stall platform, affixing with anchors every 24".

This equals to 7 anchors per 12' kickstrip, with the second and last anchor being 22" from previous anchor.

No anchors or fasteners in the Mighty Mat, just interlock and lay flat.



Expansion Joint

Install an Expansion Joint roughly every 15 mats. Making sure that the Expansion Joint is positioned under a stall loop, so as to not interfere with the comfort of the cow. Secure expansion joint with 6 anchors.
