Categories:

Traditional: Design a traditional American Scarecrow that might watch over your garden.

Your Scarecrow must be weather resistant In order to qualify for display and judging. Scarecrows should be assembled and constructed to withstand the weather and natural elements.

To enter: Please submit a written description of your entry on the back of the entry form below. The contest chair and committee reserve the right to not accept any Scarecrow which they feel may be offensive to the general public.

Please bring your scarecrow to the Cranberry Festival Office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., the week of September 7th—10th, 2010. They will be placed on light poles throughout the village of Warrens. **Please do not drop them off without filling out an entry form.**

Scarecrows may be picked up any time after the festival is over. Come to the office, and we will direct you to your Scarecrow. If you have not picked up your Scarecrow by Monday, September 27, 2010, it will be disposed of as the committee sees fit.

Judges and Committee are responsible for all decisions. ***All decisions are final.***

Prizes: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place ribbons will be awarded in each category. A best of show plaque will also be awarded to the Best Overall Scarecrow.
