**Farmer's Market information:** Deanna Donaldson 608-378-4424 please leave a message-No calls after 9:00 p.m. Deanna Donaldson is our farm market chair.

**Booth Spaces:**

- \$7.50 per frontage foot
- Sanitation Fee: \$25.00 (If you bring cardboard in-take it back with you)
- You are required to stay entirely within your booth space. Booths include a space only. We do not provide display or set-up equipment, such as tables, chairs, or tents
- Any color tents are acceptable
- You must stay for all three days. If you leave, you will not be invited back!
- No booths can be sublet to anyone!
- You are responsible for your own liability insurance. You will not be allowed to set-up without a copy in our office. A current copy must be faxed/mailed, listing Warrens Cranberry Festival Inc as (additional insured) to 402 Pine St, PO Box 146, Warrens WI 54666 or faxed to 608-378-4250.
- You may not sell soft drinks, carbonated or otherwise, or any food item that is not prepackaged; this includes apple slices, caramel apples, BBQ's, tacos etc. Only registered licensed food booths may do this. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed during show hours or you will be asked to leave.
- We will be observing booths and if we happen to see anyone extending beyond the curb, we will pull you from your spot, and you will be relocated in 2012.
- **Hawking is not allowed.**
- Non-related farm produce booths will be relocated to their appropriate area to increase their sales. Please request the right contract needed for your product. **For art & craft, flea mkt. or food booth information:** Carolyn Habelman, PO Box 146, Warrens, WI 54666 (608-378-4388) or call the cranfest office at 608-378-4200 for registration forms. Please leave a message.

**Confirmation:**

- We reserve the right to accept or reject, due to space availability and media.
- All items sold and displayed must be juried and approved.
- All items must show good taste and be family appropriate. No illegal merchandise is allowed
- You will be notified by Email that you have been accepted to participate in our show. Send a SASE if you want a written acceptance notice
- Booths that were with us last year have first chance at reserving a booth for 2010
- Your cancelled check is your receipt. .
- Your booth information, vendor permit, vendor wristbands will be mailed to the address on your application about two weeks before the event

**Weather:**

- This is an outdoor show and subject to the elements.
- The festival goes on rain or shine

**Electricity/Power:**

- We do not have electricity available
- Quiet generators are allowed.

**Sales Tax:**

- You must have a current valid Wisconsin Sales Tax Permit
- Monroe County WI Sales Tax is 5.5. %
- All vendor applications must include a copy of a current Wisconsin Sales Tax Permit Number
- Applications submitted without this information will be discarded
- Vendors are responsible for collecting & paying state sales tax. Contact the Wisconsin office with questions at 1-608-266-2776 or the website at [www.revenue.wi.gov/forms/sales/index.html](http://www.revenue.wi.gov/forms/sales/index.html) (Form BTR-101)

**Set Up Time:** All day Thursday, September 24 or until 7:00 a.m. on Friday, September 25. All vendors must be open by 7:00 a.m. all three days of the festival. You may not close Sunday until announced. Each booth is responsible for its own insurance, props, and set up.

**Vegetable Contest:** Please inquire about the Vegetable Contest at the information booth upon arriving at the Festival, or contact the Cranfest office after August 1.

**ATTENTION VENDORS**

Vendors do not extend beyond your designated areas. In the past, we have had booths extending beyond the curb. We will be observing booths and if we happen to see anyone extending beyond the curb, we will pull you from your spot, and you will be relocated in 2011. This is especially meant for booths from #47 through #59, so please pay attention to this.
