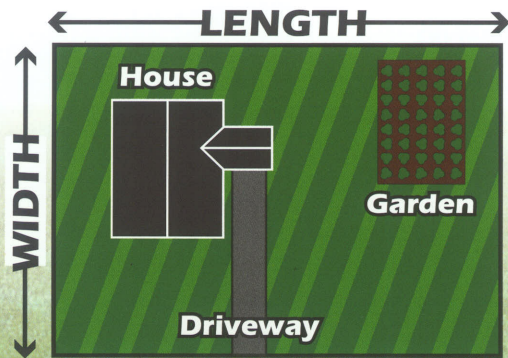
## SPREADER CALIBRATION

To provide proper distribution, calibrate spreader before application. MAXLAWN is applied at a rate of 3.2 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet of turfgrass: Check your spreader on 275 square feet and adjust to apply at the rate of 1 pound of product per 275 square feet.

It is important to follow the directions as over-application may cause injury to the lawn. Measure the size of the area to be treated and do not over or under apply. Spreader settings are approximate. Differences may occur due to condition of spreader, speed at which applied, and roughness of area treated. Calibrate spreader prior to use according to the manufacturer's directions. Check frequently to be sure equipment is working properly and distributing uniformly. Close spreader when filling, stopping or turning. Do not hand spread.

## CALCULATING TOTAL LAWN AREA

Length x Width = Total Square Feet. Then subtract non-lawn areas, such as house, garage, garden, driveway, etc.



## SPREADING PATTERNS

First spread the borders of your lawn. Then spread the center by spreading in straight line passes. Spread at a uniform walking speed to insure even coverage.
