A water bill consists of quarterly service charges for water, sanitary sewer, storm water, and fire protection plus volume charges for water and sanitary sewer.

\* Through a cooperative agreement with the City of Eau Claire, the City of Altoona sends its wastewater to be processed at the wastewater treatment plant in Eau Claire. Due to significant wastewater treatment facility upgrades being undertaken by the City of Eau Claire over the next few years, as well as normal operating costs increases, the City of Altoona has been required to increase sewer rates. Altoona sewer customers may see similar annual increases over the next few years due in part to the proposed \$35 million in wastewater plan upgrades planned by the City of Eau Claire within the next 5 years.
