Buying a used part isn't a gamble if you buy it from Kadinger's

When your vehicle is in need of a major driveline component* buying a used part may not have been your first thought. However, it should be given serious consideration. The potential for cost savings is significant and **if you choose** to purchase an extended warranty with your component from Kadinger's, you can have peace of mind that you have guaranteed coverage (parts and labor) for 1 year. Inquire with your mechanical shop or technician that is doing the work on your vehicle on what the cost would be buying a recycled part from Kadinger's. Kadinger's offers a quality part at an affordable price and now offers an extended warranty that will cover your purchase for one year that will cover not only parts but labor too. Certain requirements and restrictions apply, see next page for the details.

However, if you don't want the extended warranty coverage and price is your main concern, Kadinger's can help you too. Kadinger's has the flexibility to offer a reduced price for the price conscious individual, provided you are willing to give up some warranty coverage. Kadinger's highly recommends that you have a professional install the needed parts for your car. Improper installation is a major cause of part failure. Improper installation will void any and all warranty coverage provided by Kadinger's.

Kadinger's is pleased to offer its customers a formalized expansion of warranty coverage on major driveline components. The levels of warranty are as follows:

- 1) As is and no return
- 2) 30 Day Warranty: 30 days from date of invoice, parts only
- 3) 90 Day Warranty: 90 days from date of invoice, parts only
- 4) 6 Month Warranty: \$400 minimum on price of part, part is installed by an established and reputable mechanical shop, 6 months from date of invoice, parts only
- 5) 1 Year Parts and Labor Warranty: \$400 minimum on price of part, part is installed by an established and reputable mechanical shop, premium paid for the extra coverage, one year from date of invoice; labor covered according to Mitchell Mechanical Labor Estimating Guide, up to \$50/hour. Warranty premium to be negotiated at time of purchase.

Kadinger's reserves the right to exclude any part from any warranty level. This may be due to a high mileage or high risk component. The warranty level should be stated on the invoice.

* Major drive line components include: engine, transmission/transaxle, transfer case, rear end assembly, front axle assembly

* Kadinger's as of this time is not extending warranty coverage to big truck components.

Kadinger's Warranty Coverage

- 1) Warranties apply to the original purchaser of the part and are not transferable. (When a repair shop purchases a part that shop's customer will be considered the original purchaser.)
- 2) Warranties apply only if the part is installed in the vehicle for which it was originally purchased.
- 3) All claims must be initiated through a written claim form provided by Kadinger's and **must be accompanied by the original sales receipt.**
- 4) All claims must have written authorization by the seller before any warranty work is provided or monies refunded.
- 5) Any defective part must be made available to Kadinger's before any claim is paid.
- 6) In all cases, Kadinger's reserves the right to repair, replace, or refund the purchase price of the part, at its option. In the case of a labor warranty claim, Kadinger's must settle the labor portion of the claim when offering a purchase price refund. When warranty labor is paid, the labor warranty premium is not refundable.
- 7) Any improper use, abuse (including but not limited to overheating or low fluid levels), neglect, careless handling, damage done by improper installation or repairs, or removal of the part from the vehicle in which it was first installed shall void the warranty.
- 8) Melting of heat tabs will be considered evidence of overheating and shall void the warranty.
- 9) Unless a labor warranty is purchased, all labor costs including the cost of removing attached external parts from the purchaser's old part are not covered.
- 10) Seals, gaskets, fluids, and similar supplies are specifically excluded from this warranty.
- 11) Purchaser's loss of time, loss of vehicle use, towing expense, commercial loss and consequential damages are excluded from this warranty.
- 12) All warrant covered repairs and replacements will not extend the original warranty duration.
- 13) The use of improper or incorrect fluids will void the warranty.
- 14) Engines are considered to consist of a short block and cylinder heads. Any other parts left on the engine assembly at the time of sale are included only for purchaser convenience and are to be used at the purchaser's discretion. These parts are not covered by the warranty.
- 15) Parts used for the commercial applications, racing, off road purposed, or under any conditions that would cause greater than normal wear are excluded from this warranty.
- 16) Sheet metal is warranted against abnormal rust and corrosion with no time limit to the original purchaser.
- 17) Labor coverage is determined by multiplying the Mitchell labor guide flat rate for replacement of the part by the repair facility's labor rate, not to exceed \$50/hour.
